



HOW TO LOG YOUR READING

STEP ONE: YOUR ACCOUNT


- Visit fountaindale.org/grr and click the "Log Reading" button to access the READsquared website.
- Enter the username and PIN that was assigned to you. If you cannot log in, please ask your language arts teacher or LMC director for assistance.

STEP TWO: LOG YOUR READING

- Once logged in, click the "Log Reading" button at the top of the page or in the left-hand menu.
- You should see a pop-up window with a green banner (as shown here).
- Enter the title, author, minutes, and the date you read.
- You earn one point for every minute you log.
- Remember to log all of your reading, including reading done in class.

HOW TO ENTER THE GRAND PRIZE DRAWING

STEP ONE: YOUR ACCOUNT

- Visit fountaindale.org/grr and click the "Log Reading" button to access the READsquared website.
- Enter the username and PIN that was assigned to you. If you cannot log in, please ask your language arts teacher or LMC director for assistance.

STEP TWO: BUY YOUR TICKETS

- Once logged in, click "Grand Prizes" in the left-hand menu.
- From here you can view your current tickets and the Grand Prize details.
- To buy new tickets, click "Get Tickets," then select the prize you want to enter to win.
- You should see a pop-up window with a green banner (as shown here).
- You can update the number of tickets if you have enough points for more than one ticket.

MORE PRIZE INFORMATION

- To exchange your tickets, contact our staff at 630.685.4199 or fountaindaleteen@fountaindale.org.
- For every minute you log, you get one point, up to 500 points a day.
- One ticket costs 100 points, and you can buy up to 10 tickets.
- We will randomly select one winner for each prize at each school.
- All tickets must be purchased by Monday, October 28, to be eligible for the Grand Prize drawing.
