- Artwork must be original and free of copyright restrictions.
- All art forms welcome (crayons, pen, colored pencil, paint, digital, etc.)
- Digital artwork should be 2835 pixels x 735 pixels (2" x 8").
- Digital artwork must have a resolution of 300 dpi or higher.
- Physical entries can be turned in at the Vortex Desk.
- Digital entries can be submitted at fountaindale.org/teencontest.
- · Limit one entry per person.

- January 2025: Printed bookmarks will be available to the public, while supplies last
